Michael Trainque has submitted our first payment request to the New Hamshire Coastal Program for grant #1.

The 319 grant in collaboration with the UNH Stormwater Center to install bioretention units in various communities has been approved by DES. It is now waiting for approval by EPA and the Governor's Council. The issue was raised that 319 funding can't go to MS4 communities. This is not a issue for this grant but likely has implications for future grants.
