3.5 Recap Previous Meetings Action Items

- **Action 1.5-5** DES will make a map of all of the sub-watersheds of the coastal watershed, including Maine and Massachusetts. This map will also include municipalities. Member towns will be differentiated by a different color than non-member towns.
